Standard Outlet



Decora Outlet



GFCI Outlet



Line up the prongs in the Double Outlet Plug with the outlet openings, making sure the ground prong lines up with the lower ground opening.

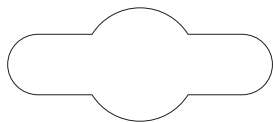
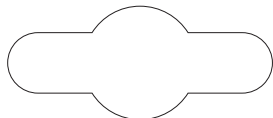
Push in until no gaps show and the Double Outlet Plug is completely flush all around.

### To Remove



Use a flat screwdriver or other object and insert in the cutout at the bottom and pull out.

Caution: Do not place objects in the outlet openings when removing the Double Outlet Plug due to risk of electrical injury.
